Complete this form to be considered for the federal Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant Program. The TEACH Grant provides up to \$4,000 per year (\$16,000 total for 4-year undergraduate program, and \$8,000 per year of which may be used at HCC) to students who commit to:

- Teaching full-time in high-need subject areas.
- For at least four out of the eight years, teaching at a school serving low-income families.

If the commitment is not fulfilled, the grant is permanently converted to a loan to be repaid by the recipient. The loan is a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan with interest calculated from the time of the grant disbursement.

### Certification

**I certify that I meet or I will meet the student eligibility requirements as follows:**

- I have completed (or will complete the 2024-2025 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- I am a U. S. citizen or eligible non-citizen, Selective Service registration (if required), Not in Title IV default or overpayment, and meet Satisfactory Academic Progress.
- I am admitted to one of the approved Houston Community College programs applicable for the TEACH Grant. (See a counselor to ensure that your two-year program of study is acceptable for full credit to a baccalaureate teacher preparation program.)
- I meet the following academic requirements: Scored above the 75th percentile on SAT, ACT, or GRE, (attach copy of your actual test scores to this application) or maintained a cumulative GPA of at least 3.25 for each term for which the TEACH Grant is disbursed.
- I am pursuing my first bachelor's degree or first master's degree.

- I will teach for four years at a school serving low-income students.

I understand that the TEACH Grant program has specific service obligations that must be met in order for the award to remain as a grant. If I fail to meet all of the conditions of the award or, if the conditions are not documented as required, I understand that the award will permanently convert to a Ford Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan and that I will be responsible to repay this loan with interest calculated from the disbursement date of the grant. I understand that once a TEACH Grant is converted to a loan, it cannot be converted back to grant.
